

Financial Assistance for Students on institutionally sponsored international travel

Financial aid may be available to eligible students who travel abroad! If you participate in an institutionally sponsored international study abroad program:

You are eligible to receive all the federal financial aid that you would have received if you were studying in the United States. Students participating in study abroad may request a budget adjustment to accommodate expenses related to their program.

What can be considered for Financial Aid?

For sponsored international programs, aid may be requested for:

Items Covered	Amount
Program Fee	100%
Airfare Up To	\$2000
Miscellaneous Up To	\$700

* If cost exceeds allotted amount, documentation can be brought to financial aid after travel has taken place to be considered on a case-by-case basis by contacting TCS Global Engagement to provide estimations. Receipts and proper documentation must be provided.

How to I apply for additional aid for my international experience?

To apply for additional aid, students must contact the financial aid office to determine if there is a need to increase their budget. If a budget increase is necessary students must complete a request for supplemental financial assistance form (provided by your FA advisor) listing estimated expenses, along with supporting documentation. Once this is submitted, the request is reviewed by the Office of Financial Aid, and a budget adjustment is completed. Financial aid adjustment notifications will provide dates and details about how the aid will be disbursed. Financial Aid can only be disbursed after the semester starts.
